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## RE: Hembree Creek Condominium Association Lock Modification Approval

The Board recently approved the installation of a combination key code entry lock to be used on any of the exterior doors to a unit.

However, the combination key code entry lock must meet the following criteria in order to be in compliance:

- polished brass construction in keeping with the existing hardware on exterior doors
- small in size (3-4" projection)
- simple design

If any of these criteria are not met, the lock will be considered a violation and appropriate action will be taken which may result in a fine being issued and/or the lock having to be removed.

You may choose to purchase a lock from anywhere so long as it complies with the specifications noted in this memo. This particular model is an example from Lowe's item #: 445627 & Model #: HKK-01P - MiProducts Corporation H-Series Polished Brass Residential-Cylinder Electronic Entry Door Deadbolt with Keypad.







## Features:

- Glow in the dark keypad, accepts up to 6, 2 to 8 digit codes
- Add or delete codes individually as needed, Built-in warning alarm sounds after 4 failed attempts
- Includes 2-traditional keys, fits standard door rep, includes 2.375"(60mm) or 2.75"(70mm) adjustable latch
- Includes optional auto-lock function, audible tones for lock, unlock, and low battery
- Requires 4-AA batteries, not included, "lock bumping" resistant pins
- Easy installation- no new wiring, 5-pin SC-1 keyway
- Lifetime tarnish free finish, simple programming
